eLearning Day Purpose

Heartland Career Center eLearning days will allow students and families the opportunity for uninterrupted learning and instruction. Today's students are required to be independent, responsible, and to have the ability to thrive in an ever-changing environment. eLearning Days will provide Heartland Career Center students the skills necessary to be productive members of a technology driven society.

What can I expect as far as instruction and assignments on an eLearning Day?

- Learning will reflect what a student is exposed to daily in class.
- Students will access resources that will enhance previously learned skills.
- Assignments should take no more than 3 hours and students will not need assistance beyond a typical classroom work.
- Students will be notified of eLearning through Remind notification once the decision has been made that Heartland Career Center will be closed.
- Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom before 9:00AM on a cancelled day.
- Assignments will be due by 3:00PM on the third school day following an eLearning day.
- Assignments will count as much as a regular class assignment.
- Attendance will be based on assignment completion. Students who do not complete assignments will be counted absent.

Attendance and Missing Assignment Clarification

- Attendance will be taken.
 - Students who do not turn in work by 3:00PM on the third school day following an eLearning day, will be counted absent for the eLearning day.

What do I do if I do not have internet at home?

Assignment details will be posted to students through Google Classroom. However, not all assignments will require internet to complete.

- If there is an issue accessing the assignment, students are encouraged to contact their instructor through email, Remind or upon return to school. Email contacts are listed on the Heartland website. <http://www.hcc.k12.in.us/>
- Students will practice the eLearning procedure prior to the implementation of eLearning.

What type of support will be given on an eLearning Day?

- Instructors will be available through email and Remind between 9:00AM - 3:00PM on an eLearning day.
- Public access points may be an option if personal WiFi is not available.
