Welcome to the Automotive Collision Repair Program. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of supplies that you will need to begin the program as well as opportunities to join an automotive club. To ensure your safety in the classroom, I would ask that you have the following items to participate fully in Auto Collision:

- Work Boots (or leather topped, solid sole shoe)

- Work Shirts (something that can get dirty)
- And an Automotive Paint Respirator

Please be aware that because of the environment and working conditions, students **will not be allowed to wear shorts and/or open-toed shoes** (crocs, sandals, etc). This will help ensure your safety.

In addition, I offer a Student Youth Organization (Club) for students called SkillsUSA. The Club cost includes a fee for registration (estimating \$20). If you are interested in participating in the Club or competitions, please be prepared to have the money available in the first two weeks of class (This is optional for all students).
